CALL TO ORDER- Chairman John Wynn called the regular meeting of the Natchitoches Parish Communications District to order on Tuesday, June 16, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. in the Natchitoches Parish Communications District 9-1-1 Center, Room 116 A, Natchitoches Parish Louisiana.

PLEDGE AND PRAYER –Chairman Wynn asked Commissioner Nicholas to lead the Pledge of Allegiance, and Commissioner Dove offered the prayer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS/INTRODUCTION OF GUEST No public comments. Mayor Jennifer Smith of Goldonna, Mark Roberts, Pat Williams, Gary McElwee, Kevin Billiot, Kris Cobbwell, Chad Himmel, and George Minturn,

Mayor Jennifer Smith of Goldonna, talked to the Commissioners about getting Letters of support for funding the rural roads.

APPROVAL/MODIFICATIONS TO AGENDA- Chairman Wynn asked were there any modifications to the agenda. Executive Director Willis Carter stated there was none.

FINANCIAL REPORT- Executive Director Willis Carter presented the Financial Report for the period ending May 31,, 2020. Chairman Wynn asked for a motion to approve the Financial Report as presented. 9-1-1 DIRECTORS REPORT and STAFF REPORT- The NATCOM facility remains on "lock down" status, limiting access to anyone other than staff. District staff has been and continues to limit "face time" in the office. NG911 State wide Planning Committee activity has been halted until after the Hurricane system currently in the Gulf has died down. ECATS reporting system failed to report for a period of four days so far in the month of June. Data is not lost but reporting was slowed for those days. As reported last month, we have received a credit refund of \$5,669.20 as the result of disconnecting two circuits which have become obsolete since installation of the new Vesta System. We were successful in having the City Fire Department main emergency reporting number redirected to the Natchitoches Police Departments call answering workstations. There was one minor glitch with regard to integration with administrative lines. Staff met with Parish President John Richmond, Mayor Jenifer Smith, Mayor of Ashland, Mr. Reed Frankland, and the Director of the Natchitoches Parish Department on June 3, 2020 call for by President Richmond in order to facilitate a discussion on street/road signs specifically in the town of Goldonna. The meeting was informative, constructive, and I believe at minimum cleared up questions about the acquisition processes related to street/road signs. We are pleased to report that I have been selected to serve on the Region 7 Louisiana Emergency Response Network (LERN) Board as a representative of 9-1-1 Communications Centers for the Region 7 area which includes Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Claiborne, DeSoto, Natchitoches, Red River, Sabine, and Webster Parishes. Radio License registration review is complete and everything is in order. Lawn maintenance has encountered some problems with access to the grounds. The manner in which interior fencing is erected restricts access to several areas on the site. There are no curb cuts to allow access to some areas and mowers are sustaining damage to equipment and parking lot curbing is sustaining damage as the result. We are exploring the installation of two 6-foot convenience gates on the interior fencing to allow the mowers to travel between, and around the paved parking lot areas. We are awaiting an estimate for that solution now. We are also exploring the installation of curb cuts in the front parking lot and relocation of trailers in the rear parking lot which may accomplish the same objective at a lower cost. Mechanical Concepts, out of Shreveport, conducted HVAC maintenance and servicing on the two Computer Room Air Conditioning units which provide support to the equipment room on May 27, 2020. A problem was detected and parts are on order at a cost of slightly over \$2000.00. We received a quote of \$2,400 from Console Cleaning Specialists for annual cleaning and maintenance of the Russ Bassett consoles in use by NPSO and NPD in the dispatch control room. We are awaiting guidance from Sunstream regarding the dimmable lighting in the dispatch control room. We need to be able to more precisely lock low light perimeters. Rutledge plumbing installed a new kitchen sink faucet and repaired a clogged faucet in the lady's restroom June 5, 2020. As reported last month, we are

currently Exploring the installation of "sneeze barriers" to be installed on the dispatch consoles. To date we have not received estimates on the cost of such barriers.

Address Coordinator Bernice Wallace, reported for the month of June, 2020 that the 9-1-1 Addressing Office processes (16) applications for new addresses for residences, and (1) address point update in Natchitoches Parish. This activity resulted in (291.30) miles being traveled throughout the Parish consuming some (30.) hours of personnel time while conducting site visual surveys and collection of GPS coordinates data. We made (0) adjustments or update to the Intrado 9-1-1 data base during this period. The District purchased (0) new or replacement road signs during the month of May, 2020. Chairman Wynn asked for a motion to accept the Directors report and 9-1-1 Address Coordinator report as presented. Motion by Commissioner Mary Jones, seconded by Commissioner Victor Jones.
