Directors discuss issues critical to emergency 9-1-1 services...

**Monroe, LA., September 27, 2012** - 9-1-1 Directors from Webster, Natchitoches, Caddo, Bienville, Jackson, Madison, Union, Ouachita and Bossier Parishes met on Thursday, September 27, 2012 in the Ouachita Parish Emergency Communications facility in Monroe, La. to discuss issues common to area 9-1-1 communications

districts. In addition to each director's update on various projects, other topics of discussion included Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and how incorrect addressing can impact emergency services, the potential benefits of assessing a fee- for addressing services including providing property markers, the trend of diminishing revenues associated with wire line telephone accounts, and the utilization of Computer-Aided-Dispatch (CAD) systems to name a few. A round table discussion on the progress of Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG911) was also conducted. Mr. David Carter, representing AT&T was present as was Mr. Gary Mirabeau, representing Pictometry. Mr. Mirabeau gave a short demonstration on digital, oblique aerial photography...
